Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

Day Work

The following activities are planned during March, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Napper Road and Smith Street	<p>Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge</p> <p>Work on the Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge will be complete by mid-March. Once opened passengers will be able to use the pedestrian footbridge to move between Parkwood station and the Parkwood park 'n' ride.</p>
Smith Street and Smith Street Motorway	<p>Temporary lane closures and speed reductions</p> <p>Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions will continue between 10:00am and 4:00pm weekdays (left lane only) to allow for finishing works on the side of the motorway and concrete barriers.</p> <p>NOTE: Night works are associated with this activity, see over for details.</p>
Various locations across the project	<p>Completion works</p> <p>Completion works including landscaping, fencing, painting and minor concrete works will continue across all areas of the light rail corridor. For your own safety, passengers and pedestrians should obey all construction and directional signage around work areas.</p> <p>Temporary footpath closure – Driftwood Park to Uplands Drive</p> <p>The footpath running from Driftwood Park to Uplands Drive <u>is now temporarily closed</u> to finalise landscaping, concreting and maintenance. Work is expected to continue into mid-March, weather and construction conditions permitting. Alternative walking and cycling routes are available via Greenacre Drive. These changes have been put into place to ensure the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and construction workers.</p> <p>Pedestrians and cyclists will be notified of the timing of the temporary closure via on site signage within Driftwood Park and along the shared path at Uplands Drive closer to the date.</p>

Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Smith Street and Smith Street Motorway	Temporary lane closures and speed reductions Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions on Smith Street and the Smith Street Motorway will continue to allow for finishing works on the concrete roadside barriers. What to expect: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Intermittent temporary lane closures between 8.00pm and 6.00am (two lanes as required) Sunday to Friday.• During these works, the speed limit will be lowered to 60km/h for the safety of motorists and construction workers. Traffic control vehicles and signage to support the lane closures and speed reductions will be in place.• Motorists should expect delays or seek an alternative route.
Various locations across the project:	Completion works During March night crews will be working across all areas of the alignment undertaking general maintenance and finishing works. For the safety of construction personnel, work on or near the track must occur in engineering hours between 1:00am and 4:00am when trams are not running on the system. Residents may experience some increased noise levels from machinery and light vehicles.
