



Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) intersection closure to Surfers Paradise Boulevard

From Monday 18 June, construction to relocate underground services and upgrade drainage will start at the intersection of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Traffic changes:

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all through traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) to Main Beach Parade (see map).

Please drive to the conditions at all times.

What to expect:

- Northbound traffic on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be redirected to the Gold Coast Highway via Cypress Avenue or can continue north to the Esplanade via Main Beach Parade.
- Southbound traffic on the Gold Coast Highway will be directed to Ocean Avenue for access to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.
- Access to Ferny Avenue northbound from the Gold Coast Highway will be maintained via a slip lane.
- Temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur. Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Excavations and crane movements to facilitate the installation and major upgrade of drainage and storm water pipes.
- Public utility works, below and above ground, including service relocations and maintenance.
- Safety fencing to contain the active work areas.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained around the construction area (see map). Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Some night works will be required for line marking, traffic management and works at Ocean Avenue. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of these works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" style reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
