



## Traffic diversions at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway)

**From Sunday 22 July, construction to relocate underground services and upgrade drainage will continue at the intersection of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Surfers Paradise Boulevard.**

### Traffic changes:

The Gold Coast Highway will be closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) to Ocean Avenue.

Southbound traffic on the Gold Coast Highway will be diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard, which will become one-way southbound to Ocean Avenue. Traffic will be given priority right turn movements into Ocean Avenue to return to the Gold Coast Highway (see map).

Northbound traffic on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be redirected to the Gold Coast Highway via Cypress Avenue or can continue north to a new signalised intersection at Ocean Avenue (see map).

Please drive to the conditions at all times.



### What to expect:

- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Median removal to facilitate traffic diversions.
- Vegetation removal to accommodate the constrained corridor and to facilitate construction activities.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements, to facilitate construction activities.
- Safety fencing to contain the active work areas.
- Temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur. Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- On-street parking along Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be progressively and permanently removed.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

### Night works:

- Night works will be required for traffic management on Sunday 22 July from 7:00pm to 6:30am. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of any further night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
