



## Underground Services Upgrade

From Thursday 6 September 2012, works to upgrade waste water services will begin along the Gold Coast Highway between the Sundale Bridge and Admiralty Drive.

Construction will occur inside the site compound at Proud Park, along the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway across Waterways Drive and within the construction area along the western side of the Gold Coast Highway.

### What to expect:

- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction will involve relocating water services and upgrading waste water services.
- Temporary service outages will occur and will be managed by the appropriate service provider.
- Affected premises will be notified prior to outages occurring in line with current legislated requirements.
- Temporary single lane closures and traffic redirections may occur between 9am and 3pm. Motorists are asked to pay attention to signage.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.



### Night works:

From Wednesday 19 September 2012, night works will take place on the Gold Coast Highway and Waterways Drive to upgrade services. This work will be undertaken for three weeks at night to minimise the impact on traffic.

- Night works to upgrade underground service crossings across the Gold Coast Highway and Waterways Drive will be required as part of these works (see map). These will be undertaken in stages to maintain traffic flow.
- Temporary work areas will be contained by safety fencing.
- Temporary lane closures and traffic redirections will occur. Motorists are asked to pay attention to signage.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Night work will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday.
