



## Barney Street works

From Wednesday October 24 2012, GoldLinQ will begin construction works in Barney Street at the northern end of the Nerang River Bridge.

These works will consist of site establishment, selective vegetation clearing, removal of three parking bays and underground service relocations. Construction works are expected to take ten weeks to complete, weather permitting.

## Traffic changes:

- Temporary lane closures periodically at the intersection of Barney Street and Brighton Parade. Traffic will be directed to the other side of Barney Street via traffic control.
- Partial cul-de-sac closure for selective vegetation clearing and removal of three parking bays.
- Relocation of walkway under the Nerang River Bridge, access will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.

## What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Selective vegetation removal to accommodate the constrained corridor and to facilitate construction activities.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

## Night works:

- Night works may be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
