

## Night Works near Ada Bell Way

From October 2012 through to early 2013, use of a laydown yard near Ada Bell Way may result in occasional noise at night.

Light rail works are being carried out in the Southport CBD and a laydown yard has been established near the **Southport Croquet Club to store** material, particularly fill resulting from night works in Scarborough Street and Nerang Street.

Night work is carried out at busy intersections and other areas minimise impacts on businesses. pedestrians and traffic during the day.



## What to expect:

- The majority of night works will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Timing of work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
