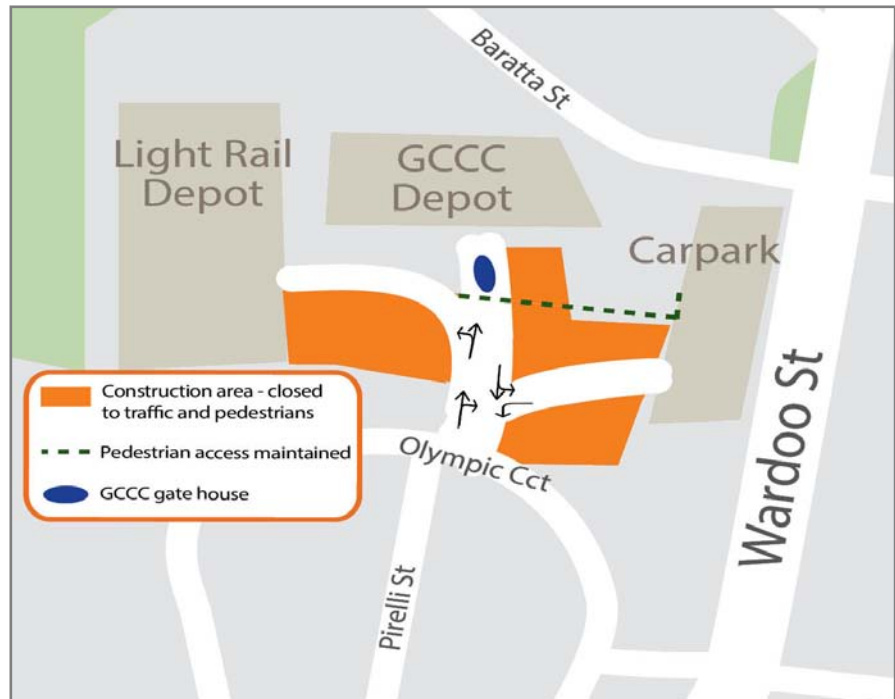


Gold Coast City Council Depot works

From Sunday 11 November 2012, GoldLinQ will begin construction within the Gold Coast City Council Depot and Michelin Street, Southport. Works will include removal of the gate house, underground services relocation and installation and pavement works. The works is expected to take seven weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Traffic changes:

- Traffic will be diverted further south when pavement is laid at on the southern side of the GCCC Depot entry/exit
- Temporary lane closures within the Depot one lane will be maintained and traffic control in place
- Reduced speed limit to 20 km/h on access road near entry gate within the GCCC Depot
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area (see map). Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and pedestrians will be re-directed along the new light rail corridor alignment



What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Vegetation removal to accommodate the constrained corridor and to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction of new footpaths, kerbs and roadway.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
