



Underground services upgrade

From Monday 19 November, works to install underground water services along the eastern side of Commodore Drive will commence and continue for up to four weeks from 6:30am to 6:30 pm, Monday to Friday.

During construction, north and southbound traffic access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained. Work will be undertaken under a stop-go traffic configuration to maintain traffic flow.

To minimise the impact on residents and traffic, the road will be reopened to two-way traffic at the close of every shift.

What to expect:

- Temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur. Traffic management will be in place to assist motorists. Please drive to the conditions at all times.
- Commodore Drive will remain open to traffic at all times.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will involve trenching for services along the eastern side of Commodore Drive.
- Heavy machinery, including excavation, to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area may occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
