



Fig Tree Relocation

From Monday 12 November 2012, GoldLinQ will begin works to relocate a fig tree within the Broadbeach South Station construction site (opposite Pacific Fair).

Due to the nature of the works required, preparations will begin on site from 4:30am, with the majority of work to be undertaken from 6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Friday.

What to expect:

- The majority of work will be undertaken within the construction area which is contained by safety barriers and hoardings.
- Heavy machinery, including crane and vehicle movements to facilitate the relocation of the fig, which is approximately 55-60 tonnes.
- The fig is being relocated to accommodate the constrained corridor and to facilitate the construction of one of the light rail's largest stations.
- Night work will be carried out between 4:30am and 6.30am, Monday to Friday.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
