

Elkhorn Avenue night works

To facilitate major public utilities upgrades, Elkhorn Avenue will be temporarily closed to all through traffic from Surfers Paradise Boulevard from 10:00pm Monday 5 November to 6:00am Tuesday 6 November.

Night works will continue at the intersection for up to four nights from Monday 5 November to facilitate construction and minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.

Night works:

- Elkhorn Avenue will be closed to all through traffic from the intersection of Surfers Paradise Boulevard from 10:00pm Monday 5 November.
- Elkhorn Avenue will be reopened to all traffic from 6:00am Tuesday 6 November.
- Alternative routes and redirections to Thomas Drive, for access to Chevron Island and Cronin Island, will be signed (see map overleaf).
- Access to the Chevron Renaissance car park will be maintained from Chevron Island.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.
 Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Night works will take place for up to four nights from Monday 5 November to Thursday 8 November between 6:30pm and 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Strict controls will be in place to minimize construction noise, light and dust.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction.
