

## Scarborough Street From White Street to Queen Street.

From Monday 26 November 2012, there will be work in the centre median area of Scarborough Street, between Queen and White Streets, to relocate underground services and prepare for track laying.

On street parking will be removed but all driveway access will be maintained.

This work is expected to take several months.

### Traffic changes:

- There will be no on street parking in Scarborough Street, between Queen and White Streets during this work.
- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
- Access to Park Lane and Owens Lane will be left in and left out only.
- The bus stops at Owens Lane and Park Lane will be moved further north along Scarborough Street (see map overleaf).
- Pedestrian access will be maintained along the footpath.
- Temporary lane closures and traffic changes. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place.
- The speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/hr.

### What to expect:

- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements, to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

## Night works:

- Some night work will be required to minimise impacts on traffic and businesses. Work will be between 6:30pm and 6:30am Sunday to Thursday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” style reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
