


Queen and Nerang Street intersection works

From 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday on the weekends of 30 November to 3 December and 7 December to 10 December 2012, the intersection of Queen and Nerang Street, Southport, will be partially closed.

Construction crews will work around the clock to prepare the intersection for tracklaying during the quieter weekend traffic period.



Traffic changes:

- Partial closure of the intersection of Queen and Nerang Street (see map 1).
- Queen Street eastbound will be closed just past Carey Lane. Motorists will need to detour via Whitby Street (see map 2 overleaf).
- Motorists heading east along Nerang Street will have to detour via Queen Street.
- Motorists will still be able to travel westbound along Queen Street.
- Access to Carey Lane will be maintained via a break in the median construction zone.
- Local driveway access will be maintained via traffic control and a break in the work area for businesses in Nerang Street near Queen Street.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.

What to expect:

- Construction crews will work from 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday on the weekends of Friday 30 November to Monday 3 December and Friday 7 December to Monday 10 December to ensure the intersection is re-opened to motorists by 6:00am.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
