

Scarborough Street works

From Monday 3 December 2012 the bus stops outside Australia Fair will be closed and relocated north along Scarborough Street to outside the Police station and TAFE.

At the same time Nerang Street, between Davenport and Scarborough Streets, will be permanently closed to through traffic.

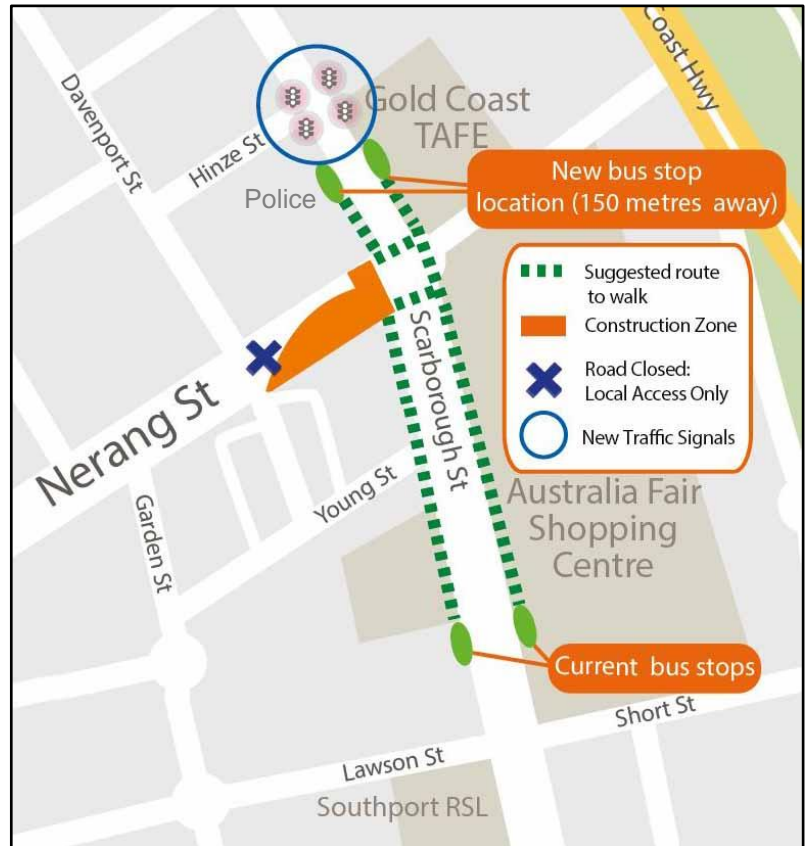
Underground services work, including water and electricity relocations and upgrades, will begin in Scarborough Street outside Australia Fair, between Short Street and Young Street.

Traffic changes:

- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction in Scarborough Street outside Australia Fair.
- There will be no through traffic in Nerang Street between Davenport and Scarborough Street.
- Businesses that have driveway access in this area will still have access from Davenport Street.
- A new set of traffic signals will be in operation at the intersection of Hinze and Scarborough Streets.
- Buses will stop at the new bus station outside the Police station and TAFE in Scarborough Street.
- One pedestrian crossing will be maintained outside Australia Fair but the location may vary during construction.
- The speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/h and traffic controllers and signage will direct motorists.

What to expect:

- Heavy machinery, with excavation and crane movements, to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- During the day construction will be between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday,
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.



Nerang Street closure and Scarborough Street bus stop changes

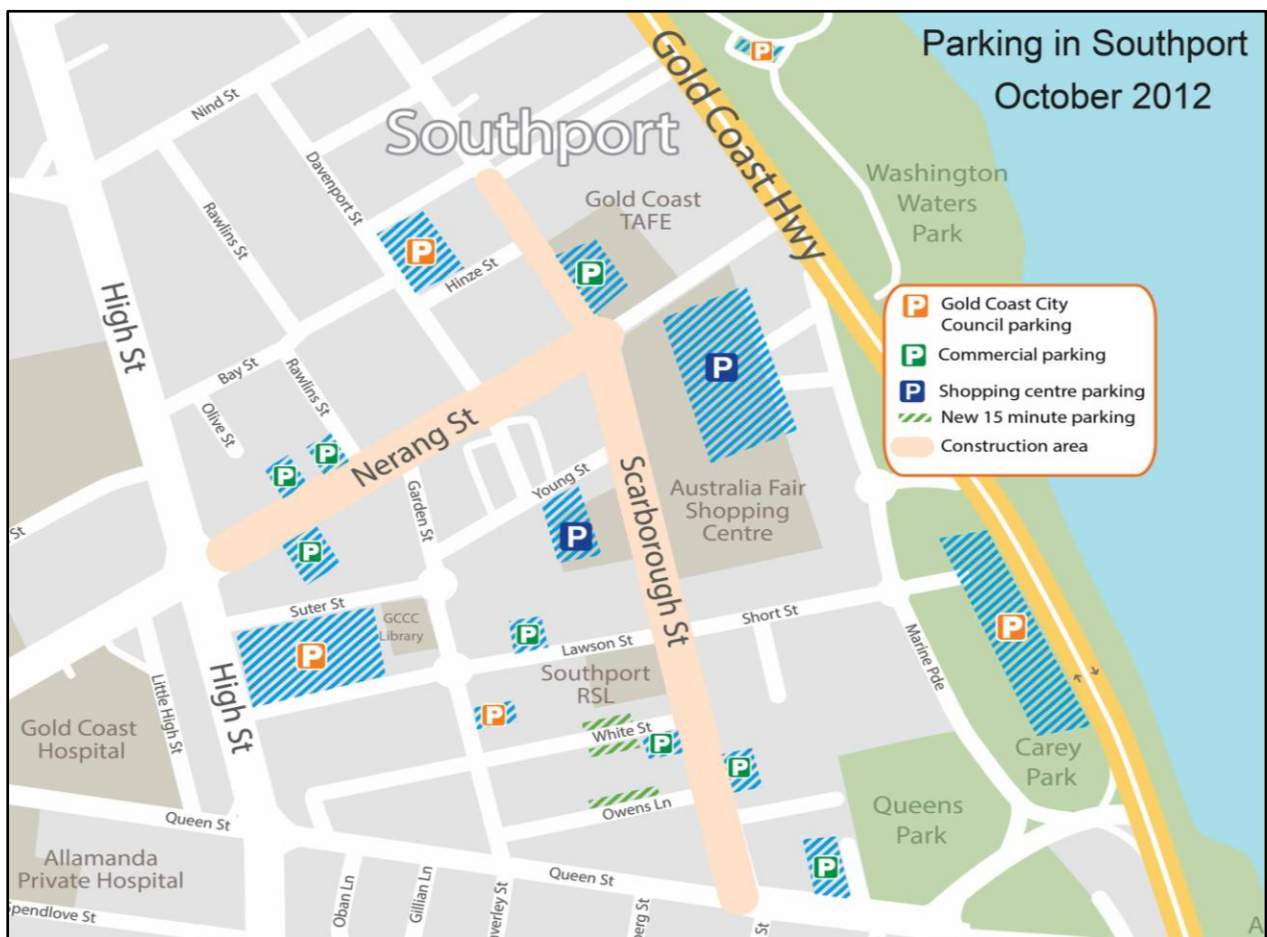

Night works:

- Some night work will be required to minimise impacts on traffic and businesses. Work will be between 6:30pm and 6:30am Sunday to Thursday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” style reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
