



Track works Gold Coast Highway

From Monday 10 December 2012, GoldLinQ will progress with rail laying preparation works along the Gold Coast Highway from Fern Street to Wharf Road, Broadbeach. These works are anticipated to take six weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Works will consist of:

- Track form construction
- Rail delivery
- Welding
- Concrete pours
- Track laying

Please note that construction works will cease in this area between 22 December and 6 January.



Traffic changes:

- Temporary lane closures. These closures will be under traffic control.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area (see map). Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.

What to expect:

- Majority of works to occur within the dedicated light rail corridor in the middle of the Gold Coast Highway between Fern Street and Wharf Road.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Periodic rail delivery will occur on the Gold Coast Highway at off-peak times.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Periodic rail delivery between 7:00pm and 5:00am Sunday to Thursday.
- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
