

Fern Street partial intersection closure

From Monday 14 January 2013, GoldLinQ will partially close the intersection of Fern Street and the Gold Coast Highway.

This closure is to facilitate:

- Earthworks
- Drainage
- Service relocations
- Rail delivery
- Concrete pours
- Track laying

It is anticipated the works will take twelve weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Traffic changes:

- The intersection of Fern Street and the Gold Coast Highway will be partially closed. Left in left out only.
- Bus route 750 will be temporarily detoured via Wharf Road.
- Bus stops on Old Burleigh Road will be temporarily relocated to Wharf Road (see map).
- During these works a U Turn facility will be provided on Gold Coast Highway at intersection with Wharf Road.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Periodic rail delivery will occur on the Gold Coast Highway at off-peak times.

What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- Rail delivery will periodically occur between 7:00pm and 5:00am Sunday to Friday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
