



Hooker Boulevard Gold Coast Highway intersection works

From Tuesday 29 January 2013, works to upgrade and relocate services will begin at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard/Nerang-Broadbeach Road, Margaret Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway.

The majority of works will be within construction compounds with periodic road crossings of all intersections. These works are anticipated to take 14 weeks to complete, with a combination of day and night works to minimise impacts on traffic.

Traffic changes:

To facilitate construction, GoldLinQ will implement the following traffic changes:

- Temporary left-hand slip lane closures of Nerang-Broadbeach Road and Hooker Boulevard during night works.
- Temporary lane closures of Gold Coast Highway at off-peak times.
- Intersection works under police control.
- Reduced speed limit to 40 km/h.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area may occur and alternative routes will be signed.

What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Temporary service outages may occur and will be managed by the appropriate service provider.
- Affected premises will be notified prior to outages occurring in line with current legislated requirements.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise impacts on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
