



## Gold Coast Light Rail

Week commencing Monday 17 December 2012

### Parklands

#### Parklands Drive works progressing

The Engineering Drive intersection has been signalised with right turn entry reinstated to Parklands Gold Coast. The temporary bus stop at Parklands Drive has been relocated to a new position on the south-east side of the Engineering Drive intersection.

The footpath on the University side of Parklands Drive from Engineering Drive to Alumni Place has been closed to pedestrians with a construction zone established to allow excavation and preparation for trackform work to occur.

#### Gold Coast University Hospital Station Shell

Detailed excavation works for stairwells up to Griffith University are underway ahead of formwork, reinforcement and pouring of concrete.

Work on footing for precast concrete wall panels and installation of underground services continues.

#### Smith Street Bridge and Depot

The delivery and placement of bridge spans along Parklands Drive and across the Smith Street Motorway has been completed with four spans now in place.



### Depot

Piling and retaining wall works continue within the Depot. Construction of walls for the equipment room and reception area of the Depot facility is now complete, along with back filling of retaining walls around the tram maintenance pits.

Form work will now commence for the first floor of the structure, which will continue into the New Year.

### Southport

#### Scarborough Street traffic change

Works continue along Scarborough Street relocating underground services between Lawson and Nerang Streets and excavating for track laying between White and Queen Streets.

#### Night works

On Monday night there will be sewer pipe relining work in Lawson Street near Scarborough Street.

On Wednesday and Thursday nights there will be sewer relining work across Young Street near Scarborough Street.

#### Nerang Street

Track laying excavations continue outside the hospital. Parking is available at nearby Athol Paterson car park in Suter Street.

Underground services relocating work continues between Davenport and Scarborough Streets.

#### Queen Street

Track laying works continue with steel fixing, welding and concrete pouring. There will be an eastbound lane closure and night works on Sunday night to allow for a concrete pour.

### Nerang River and Main Beach

[Underground services work continues on Barney Street. The walkway under the bridge will remain open.](#)

#### Light Rail Vehicle (LRV) bridge piling

[Piling at the Southern end of the Gold Coast Bridge near Proud Park continues.](#)

## Paradise Waters

### Ongoing works

Earth works from the Gold Coast Bridge to Admiralty Drive continue to prepare for construction of the light rail bridge and trackform.

Rail delivery and the construction of trackform along the Gold Coast Highway, Surfers Paradise will continue.

Works to install for underground services at Macintosh Island North and South Bridges will continue this Sunday 16 December from 7:00am. Limited impacts are expected, affected stakeholders have been advised.

## Surfers Paradise

### Construction halted for Christmas

Construction in Surfers Paradise from View Avenue to Beach Road has been suspended for the Christmas holiday season. Construction activities will recommence 29 January 2013.



### Ferny Avenue intersection

Major construction at the intersection of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Surfers Paradise Boulevard continues.

### Ocean Avenue to View Avenue works commence

Construction has commenced on Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Ocean and View Avenues. Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now one-way southbound. Pandanus Avenue is closed to Surfers Paradise Boulevard, however, access from the Gold Coast Highway will be maintained.

### Night works along Surfers Paradise Boulevard

Works to upgrade underground services have commenced and will occur at night at various locations along Surfers Paradise Boulevard until 20 December. Limited impacts are expected, affected stakeholders have been advised.

### Traffic one-way on Surfers Paradise Boulevard

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now one-way southbound from Ocean Avenue to Cavill Avenue and from Clifford Street to Thornton Street. During construction, Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be progressively and permanently changed to southbound traffic only.

### Construction south of Clifford Street

Works to upgrade underground services in this area continue. Temporary lane changes and points of access may change during construction. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.

### Track works Markwell Avenue to Vista Street

Works to prepare for rail delivery have commenced along the western side of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Markwell Avenue and Vista Street.

## Broadbeach

### Gold Coast Highway opposite Main Place

From Monday 17 December, works to upgrade and relocate services will begin along the eastern and western sides of the Gold Coast Highway between Queensland Avenue and Victoria Avenue.

### Drainage works

Drainage works on the western side of the Gold Coast Highway outside the Gold Coast Convention Centre will be completed by 21 December.
