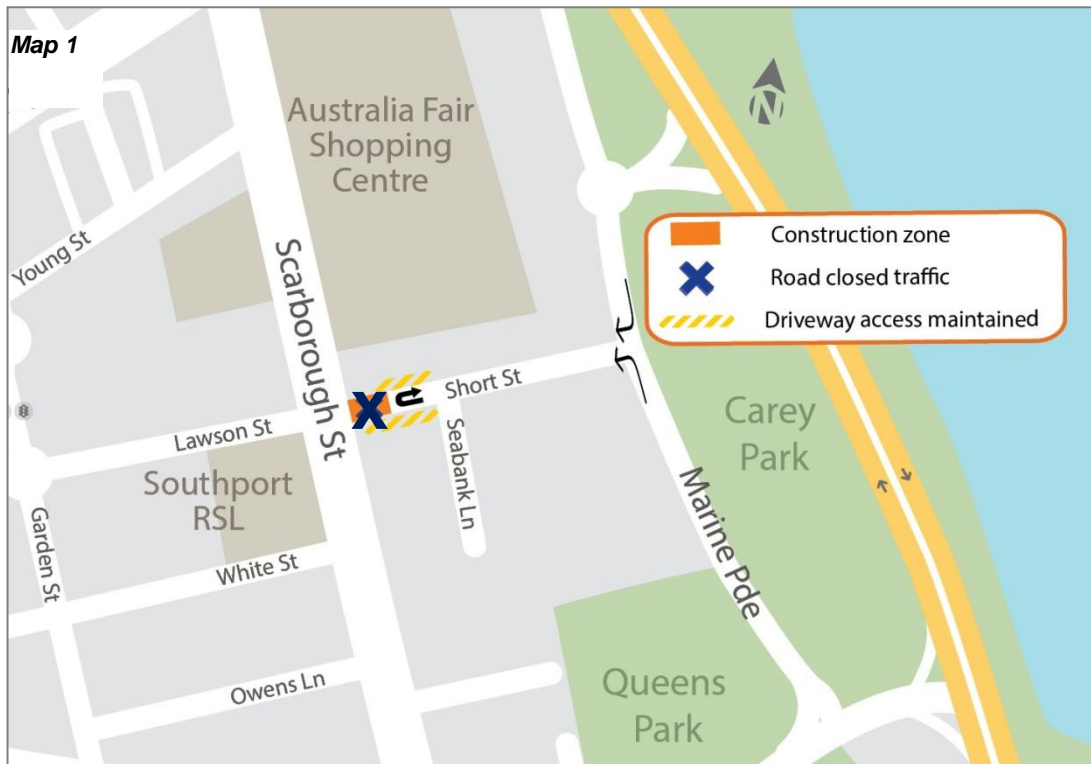


## Short Street closure

From Monday 14 January 2013, Short St, Southport, will be closed to through traffic for several months.

This is to allow the installation of storm water drainage as part of the infrastructure upgrade in Southport.



### Traffic changes:

- Short Street will be closed at the intersection of Scarborough Street (see map 1).
- Motorists will need to detour via Marine Parade and Queen Street or Nerang Street.
- Access to local businesses and driveways will be maintained by entering Short Street from Marine Parade.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.

### What to expect:

- Construction crews will work between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these.
- Some night works may be required.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

**Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.**
