

Lawson Street closure

From Sunday 17 March 2013 Lawson Street, Southport, will be closed at the Scarborough Street for several weeks.

This is to allow the installation of storm water drainage as part of the infrastructure upgrade in Southport.


Traffic changes:

- A full closure of the intersection will be required (see map).
- A single traffic lane will be opened when construction allows.
- Motorists should detour via Garden Street, High Street or White Street.
- Access to local businesses, the RSL car park, and driveways will be maintained by entering Lawson Street from Garden Street or High Street.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.

What to expect:

- Construction crews will work between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.
- Some night works will be required.
- Detours will be signed.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
