



Night works on Cavill Avenue

From Tuesday 2 July 2013, night works to install underground services will begin on the northern footpath of Cavill Avenue and continue west towards the Gold Coast Highway. These works are anticipated to take up to three weeks to complete.

To minimise the impact on surrounding residents and businesses, works in the intersection of Cavill Avenue will be completed within 48 hours and further night-works will only take place from Sunday to Thursday nights.

What to expect:

- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Temporary footpath closures on the northern footpath will occur at night. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Single lane closures will occur and traffic management will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Sunday to Thursday, 12:00pm to 10:00am.
