

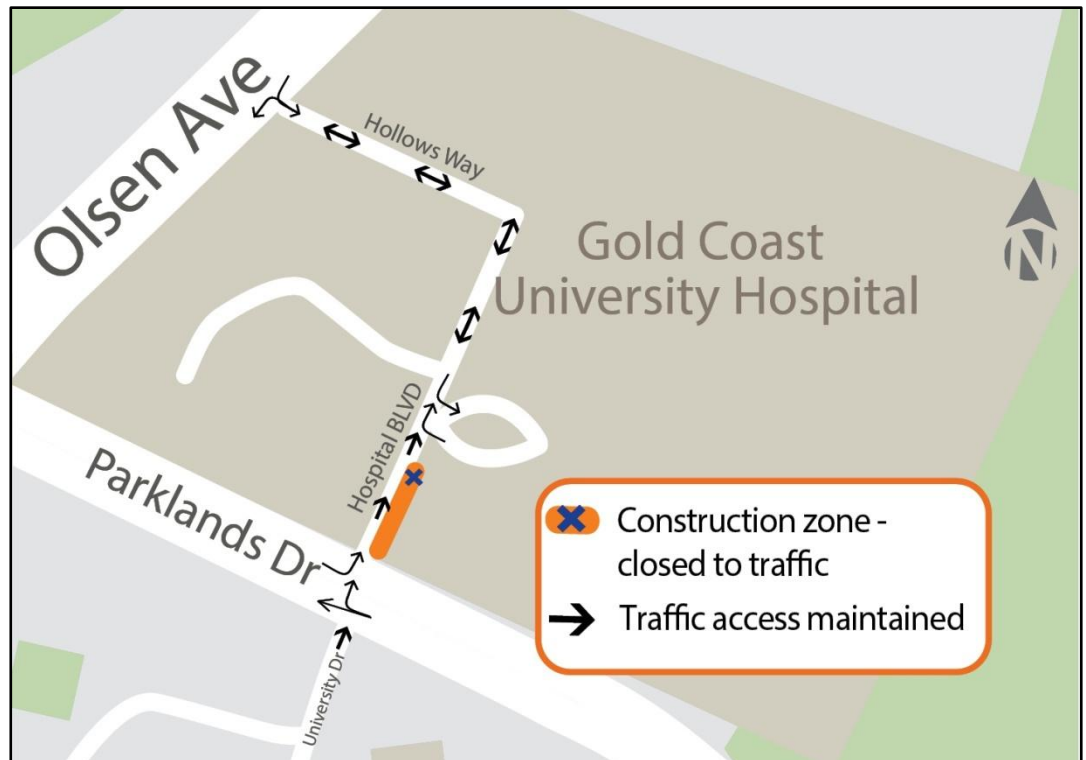
Exit lane closure at Gold Coast University Hospital Sunday 10 November

On Sunday 10 November 2013 the exit lane from the Gold Coast University Hospital on to Parklands Drive will be closed to allow new escalators to be installed in the underground light rail station.

Motorist's entry into the hospital from Parklands Drive will not be affected.

Detour signs and traffic controllers will guide motorists to exit on to Olsen Avenue.

Pedestrian access will be available at all times.



Changed exit route for traffic at GCUH while escalators are lifted in to the light rail station on Sunday 10 November.

What to expect:

- Work will start early at 4am on Sunday morning and is planned to be completed by 4pm.
- Installation of the escalators is expected to take one day.
- Four escalators will be delivered on a semi trailer and lifted off and lowered down into the station one at a time
- There will be a crane and construction machinery in the vicinity.
- There will be safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Traffic controllers and detour signs will be in place.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
