



Admiralty Drive Underground Service Works

From Monday 7 January 2013, works to install underground services from the Council land reserve near Neptune Court to Jarri Parilla Cove will begin. These works will continue for up to four weeks to facilitate the installation of major wastewater services.

What to expect:

- Admiralty Drive will remain open to traffic at all times.
- Temporary work areas will be contained by safety fencing.
- Construction will involve trenching and boring for services from the Council land reserve near Neptune Court, under the Nerang River at Macintosh Island South, to Jarri Parilla Cove to install underground wastewater services.
- Heavy machinery, including excavation and boring, to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area may occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Friday.
- Some night works may be required as part of these works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers, if required, will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
