

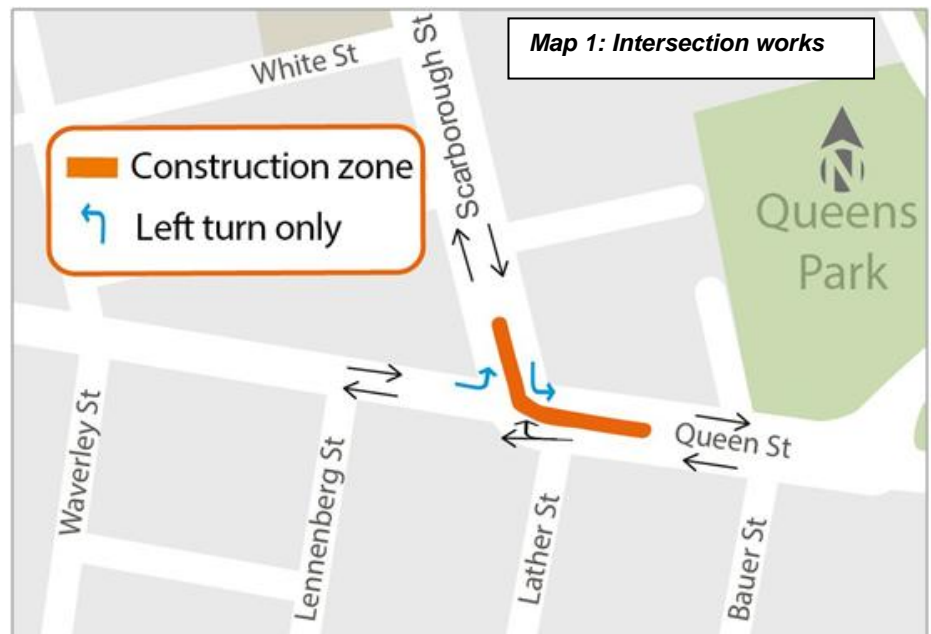
Scarborough and Queen Street intersection works

From 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday on the weekends of 1 to 4 and 15 to 18 February 2013, the intersection of Scarborough Street and Queen Street, Southport, will be partially closed.

Construction crews will work around the clock to prepare the intersection and lay track during the quieter weekend traffic period. Motorists are advised to avoid these road works and seek alternative routes where possible.

Traffic changes:

- Partial closure of the intersection of Scarborough and Queen Street (see map 1).
- Queen Street eastbound will be closed to through traffic. Motorists will need to detour via Scarborough Street to reach the Gold Coast Highway (see map 2 overleaf).
- There will be no right turn from Scarborough Street to Queen Street. Motorists heading south along Scarborough Street will have to detour via White Street.
- Motorists will still be able to travel westbound along Queen Street.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.



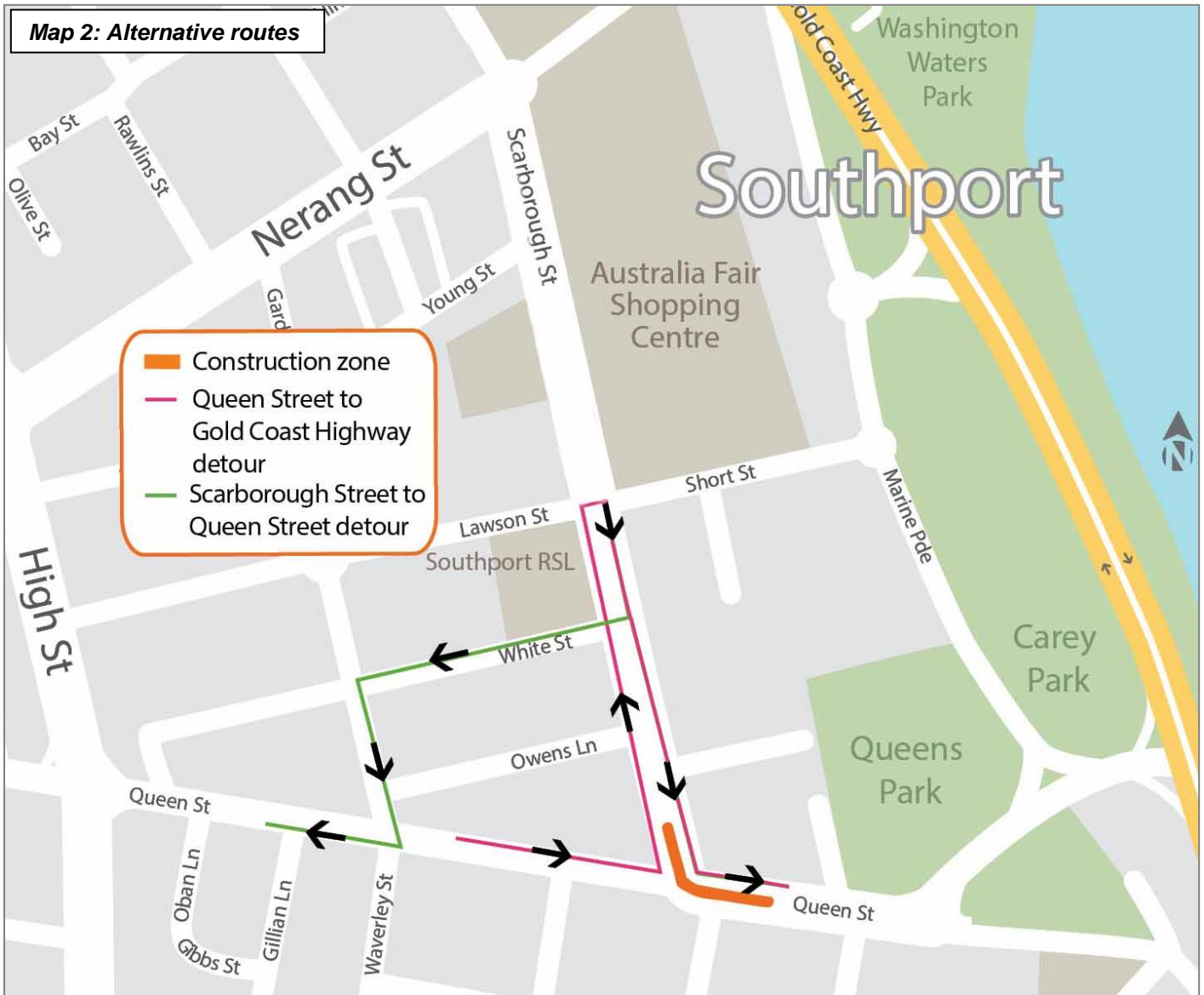
What to expect:

- Construction crews will work from 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday over the weekends to ensure the intersection is re-opened to motorists by 6:00am.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residence.
- Traffic controllers and detour signs will be in place.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
