

Young Street closure

From 6:30pm Sunday 24 February 2013, the intersection of Young and Scarborough Street, Southport, will be closed for two weeks.

This is to allow the installation of water and telecommunications services as part of the infrastructure upgrade in Southport.

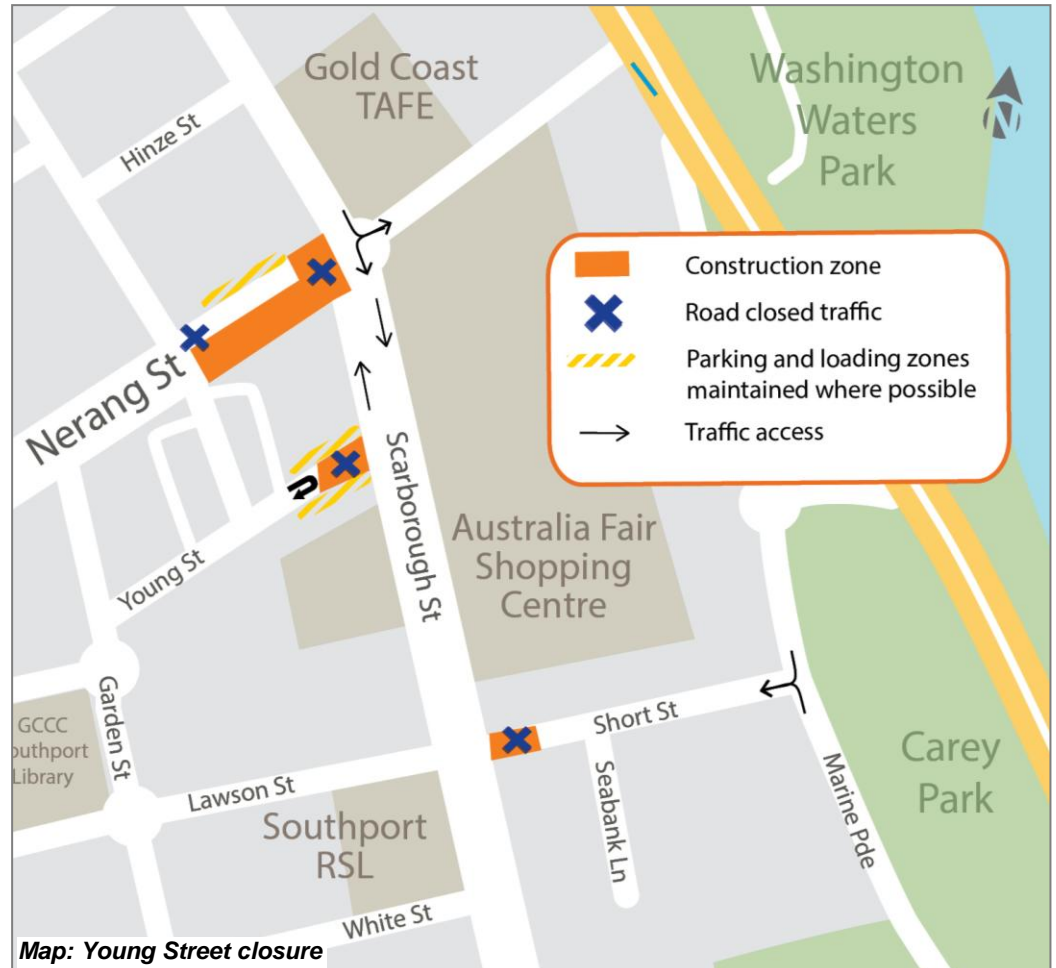
Traffic changes:

- Young Street will be closed to motorists at the intersection of Scarborough Street.
- Motorists should detour via Lawson Street.
- Access to local businesses and driveways will be maintained by entering Young Street from Garden Street.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.
- Access to loading zones and on-street parking will be maintained when possible.

What to expect:

- Construction crews will work between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.
- Some night works will be required.
- Detours will be signed.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
