



Construction continues on Surfers Paradise Boulevard – Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Construction continues on Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Ocean Avenue and View Avenue.

Relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage will continue on both eastern and western sides of Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

New activities include new kerb and pavement works on the eastern side of the boulevard and further drainage work in preparation for track construction on the western side of the boulevard.

Traffic changes:

Surfers Paradise Boulevard remains one-way southbound from Ocean Avenue to View Avenue.

Minor traffic switches will occur along Surfers Paradise Boulevard as work is switched from eastern to western sides.

Pandanus Avenue will be closed to Surfers Paradise Boulevard for the duration of construction.

To facilitate track laying, intersection and block closures of up to six weeks will occur along the alignment as work progresses. Local access will be maintained at all times.

Affected residents and businesses will receive advanced notice prior to future closures. Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.


Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.

What to expect:

- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area (see map). Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather and construction conditions.

Night works:

- Future night works may be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
