



Traffic diversions at Ferny Avenue Intersection

From Thursday 28 March to Tuesday 2 April 2013, an additional southbound traffic lane will be opened along Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) from the intersection with Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

The additional lane will accommodate increased traffic flow to Surfers Paradise during the Easter long weekend. To assist in opening an extra southbound lane nightworks will take place on Tuesday 26 March and Wednesday 27 March. However, no construction will be undertaken in the precinct from Thursday 28 March to Tuesday 2 April 2013 inclusive.

Traffic changes:

- Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) will retain two lanes northbound.
- One lane southbound will be introduced on Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) from the intersection with Surfers Paradise Boulevard (see map overleaf).
- The existing southbound lanes on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be maintained.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard and Ocean Avenue remain one-way.
- Traffic signals at the intersection of the Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Ocean Parade will be altered to assist traffic movements at the intersection.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.

Night works:

- Night works will be required on Tuesday 26 and Wednesday 27 March from 7:00pm to 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
