



## Scarborough Street and Southport works

Changes in traffic conditions are occurring in Scarborough Street as part of the next phase of light rail construction in Southport.

Asphalt laying and kerbing along the western side of Scarborough Street between Lawson and Nerang Streets is being completed. Traffic will then move to the western side of Scarborough Street to allow extensive stormwater drainage and pavement work on the eastern side.

Track laying at the corner of Nerang and Scarborough Street has been completed and station construction will start in Nerang Street, between Scarborough and Davenport Streets, towards the end of April.

Access to driveways between Young Street and Nerang Street is now permanently left in and left out only.

Trackform preparation and rail laying is occurring at the southern section of Scarborough Street between Queen Street and White Street. Sewer and stormwater drainage works are occurring between White Street and Australia Fair.

In approximately late June track laying preparations will start in the remaining centre median area from Young Street to White Street.

### Traffic changes:

- Two way traffic will continue to be maintained on Scarborough Street.
- Short Street will reopen in June.
- Lawson Street will remain closed at Scarborough Street for several weeks with single lane access maintained when possible.
- Young Street will be reopened to left in and left out traffic in approximately late April.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area but the points of access and crossing may change.

### What to expect:

- Construction crews will work between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.
- Some night works will be required.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services, kerbing and pavement works, track form preparation and the delivery and laying of 18 metre rail lengths.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residence.
- Traffic controllers and detour signs will be in place.
