

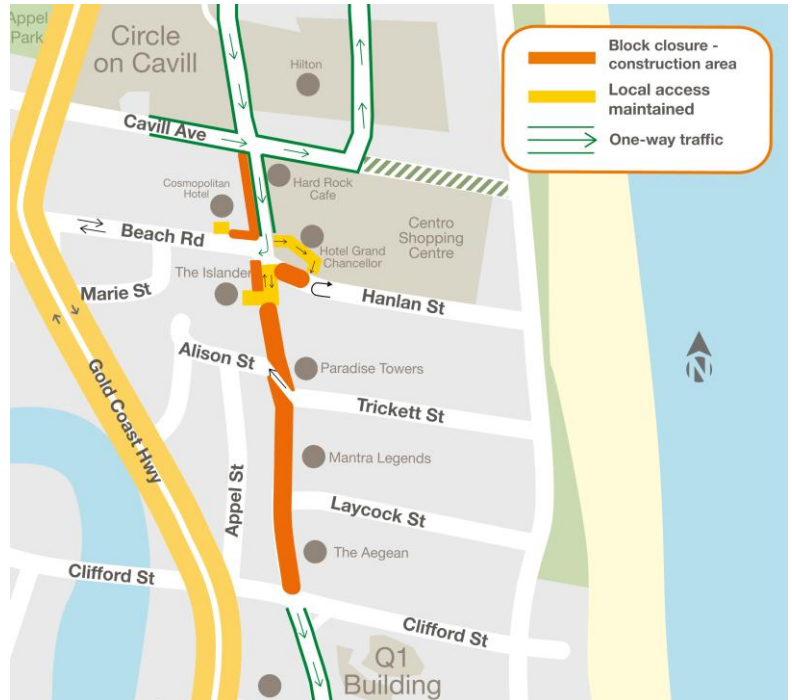
Hanlan Street and Surfers Paradise Boulevard intersection works

From Wednesday 26 June 2013, major underground services upgrades across Hanlan Street, Surfers Paradise, will begin.

To facilitate construction, the intersection of Hanlan Street and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed.

Traffic changes:

- The intersection of Hanlan Street and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all through traffic (see map).
- For access to Hanlan Street local residents and businesses will be redirected to the Esplanade.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.



What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Temporary service outages will occur and will be managed by the appropriate service provider. Affected premises will be notified prior to outages occurring in line with current legislated requirements.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
