

Night works at Margaret Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway

From Wednesday 3 April 2013, night works to upgrade and relocate underground services will begin at the intersection of the Gold Coast Highway and Margaret Avenue and continue for three weeks.

To minimise the impact on surrounding residents and businesses, every effort will be made to complete disruptive works by midnight.

What to expect:

- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery to relocate underground services.
- Temporary lane closures on the Gold Coast Highway southbound and at Margaret Avenue will occur.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at the intersection under traffic control.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30pm and 6:30am, Monday to Friday.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
