



Night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard

From Wednesday 22 May 2013, night works to install underground services will begin along the eastern footpath of Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Markwell Avenue to Hamilton Avenue and continue for up to six nights.

To minimise the impact on surrounding residents and businesses, every effort will be made to complete disruptive works by midnight.

What to expect:

- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Temporary service outages will occur and will be managed by the appropriate service provider. Affected premises will be notified prior to outages occurring in line with current legislated requirements.
- Temporary footpath closures on the eastern footpath will occur. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Sunday to Thursday, 6:30pm to 6:30am.
