

Ada Bell Way and Queen Street intersection works

From 6:30pm Friday 19 April to 5:00am Monday 22 April, 2013 the intersection of Ada Bell Way and Queen Street, Southport, will be partially closed to lay light rail tracks.

Construction crews will work around the clock during the quieter weekend traffic period.



Traffic changes:

- Partial closure of the intersection of Ada Bell Way and Queen Street (see map 1).
- Access to Queen Street near the Shores will be via detour (see map 2 overleaf).
- There will be no right turn from Queen Street eastbound towards The Shores.
- There will be no right turn from Queen Street westbound into Ada Bell Way. Motorists should detour via Scarborough Street, White Street and Garden Street.
- Through traffic from the Gold Coast Highway to Ada Bell Way and Queen Street will be maintained in both directions.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area.

What to expect:

- Construction crews will work from 6:30pm Friday to 5:00am Monday to ensure the intersection is re-opened to motorists by 6:00am.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will include excavation and installation of underground services.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.



Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
