



Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 6 May 2013



Parklands

Track laying works adjacent to Alumni Drive continue.

Depot

Administration building and track laying works continue. Concrete pours for track form continue between the Depot and Wardoo Street.

Southport

Queen Street

Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Installation of overhead line poles and preparation work for station construction continue. There will be night time lane closures in both directions. Local access will be maintained.

Nerang Street

Installation of overhead line poles continues.

Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation, concrete pouring, rail delivery and kerb work continue. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

Davenport Street intersection

Work continues on an Energex substation.

Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Track laying and station preparation continues.

Scarborough Street

Scarborough Street Traffic Changes

There will be traffic changes between Nerang Street and Queen Street. Traffic in both directions will be maintained however driveway entry points may change. All changes will be managed by traffic controllers and signage.

Outside the Dick Smith store

Asphalting and pavement reinstatement works will finish.

Between Young Street and Lawson Street

Traffic will move to the western side of the road to allow for drainage works to commence on the eastern side of the road.

Between Lawson Street and White Street.

Traffic will move to the centre median to allow for drainage works to commence.

Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying will occur in the centre median. Works building an Energex pit on the western footpath will continue at night, with some lane closures required.

Between Short Street and Australia Fair

Kerb laying and asphaltting will occur.

Between Short Street and Park Lane

Water main works continue opposite the RSL.

Between Westpac and Queen Street

Kerbing and asphalt works will occur. Energex works continue with some night time lane closures required.

Young Street

Young Street will reopen to traffic in both directions.

Lawson Street

Kerb laying and excavation work for storm water drainage continues. Lawson Street will be closed for several weeks. Traffic will be maintained in both directions on Scarborough Street.

Short Street

All access to Short Street will be via Marine Parade while stormwater pipes are installed. Short Street will reopen to through traffic at the Scarborough Street intersection in mid June.

Queen Street

Near the Croquet Club

Track laying preparation and drainage work continues.

Barney Street

Track preparation works continue. The fishing platform has been reopened.

Nerang River

Piling works on the north and south sides of the Nerang River continue for the light rail vehicle bridge.

Nerang River Barge Movements

Paradise Waters

Construction along the Gold Coast Highway from the Gold Coast Bridge to Admiralty Drive continues.

Admiralty Park

Works to install underground services at Admiralty Park continue.

Admiralty Drive

Works to lay rail across Admiralty Drive will continue for up to six weeks. North and south bound traffic access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained, however points of access may change.

Surfers Paradise

Ferny Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling will recommence between Ferny Avenue and Main Beach Parade.

Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Nightworks will take place on Wednesday 8 May including a temporary road closure of Surfers Paradise Boulevard just after Ocean Avenue. Local access will be maintained.

Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Underground service upgrades continue with works to be completed at night between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday. Surfers Paradise Boulevard is closed to all through traffic between Elkhorn Avenue and Cavill Avenue.

Cavill Avenue to Clifford Street

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now one-way southbound between Cavill Avenue and Clifford Street. From mid-May there will be no access from Beach Road onto Surfers Paradise Boulevard. Hanlan Street will be left turn only onto the boulevard. There will also be no access into Hanlan Street from Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Works to install upgrade and install underground services along the western footpath will begin. Temporary footpath closures will occur; access will be maintained for all businesses.

Trickett Street to Laycock Street

Works to install underground services inside the construction zone continue.

Clifford to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between [Clifford and Thornton Street](#) remain closed. East to west traffic movements are maintained at most intersections except Markwell Avenue which is currently closed.

Clifford Street to Hamilton Avenue

Works to upgrade and install underground services continue. Works to upgrade traffic signals at the Hamilton Avenue intersection will begin.

Hamilton Avenue to Markwell Avenue

Works to install track in this area continue.

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Markwell Avenue intersection to Enderley Avenue

Markwell Avenue intersection is closed to all east to west traffic movements. Rail will be delivered this week and track installation continues. Works to install services in the eastern and western footpaths will begin. Temporary footpath closures will be in place.

Enderley Avenue Intersection to Vista Street

Works to install rail across the Enderley Avenue intersection continue. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals.

Underground service works continue south towards Vista Street and west of the intersection along Enderley Avenue. Temporary footpath closures will occur.

Vista Street to Thornton Street

Works to install rail across the Thornton Street intersection continue. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals.

Underground service upgrades across Vista Street and along the eastern footpath continue. Traffic management will be in place to assist vehicles and pedestrians.

Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

Main Place

Underground service works continue on the Gold Coast Highway adjacent to Main Place. Periodic temporary lane closures on the highway will occur during night works.

Elizabeth Avenue intersection

Underground service works are progressing at the intersection of Elizabeth Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway. The intersection will be re-opened to traffic from 20 May 2013, weather permitting.

Hooker Boulevard and Jupiter's Casino Road

Lane closures at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard and Jupiter's Casino Road will occur between Monday 6 May and Wednesday 8 May. Jupiter's Casino northbound bus stop will be closed.

For northbound 745 bus services please use Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre bus stop on the Gold Coast Highway. For northbound 750 bus services please use Victoria Park bus stop on Surf Parade (see map below).

Monaco Street Intersection

Works continue at the intersection of Monaco Street and the Gold Coast Highway. North and south bound detours are available via St Kilda Avenue and Wharf Road.

Wharf Road

Works continue at the intersection of the Gold Coast Highway and Wharf Road. Periodic temporary lane closures will occur.

Queensland Avenue

Underground service works continue on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway.



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
