

Queen Street landscaping works

From 20 May 2013 landscaping works will occur in Queen Street between Wardoo Street and Nerang Street. Lane closures for both eastbound and westbound traffic will be required at various times between 9:30am and 2:30pm and from 6:30pm to 6:30am for up to three weeks.

Local access will be maintained and closures will not occur in both directions at the same time.

Traffic changes:

- During this work sections of Queen Street between Wardoo Street and Nerang Street will be closed. For ongoing information on these closures visit goldlinq.com.au and sign up for the weekly construction update.
- Local residential access will be maintained however short term delays may occur. Residents need to be aware that following traffic control directions is vital for their safety.
- Limited pedestrian access around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- GoldLinQ is working closely with the Southport Cemetery and visitor access will be restricted at certain times during eastbound lane closures. There will be no interruptions to burial services at Southport Cemetery.

What to expect:

- Detours and traffic management measures including traffic control and Variable Message Signs will be in place.
- Excavation machinery and vacuum trucks to assist with planting, placement of top soil and mulching.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residents.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
