



Night works on the Gold Coast Highway

From Thursday 11 April, night works to install underground services will begin along the Gold Coast Highway, adjacent to Australis Sovereign Resort, and continue until Friday 26 April 2013.

To minimise the impact on surrounding residents and businesses, every effort will be made to complete disruptive works by midnight.

What to expect:

- Vibrational piling will occur at night from 6:30pm to 10:30pm from Thursday 11 April to Tuesday 16 April 2013.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Temporary lane closures on the Gold Coast Highway northbound will occur during these works.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained under traffic control.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
