

## **Night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard**

From Sunday 12 May, night works to install underground services will begin along the eastern footpath of Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Laycock Street to Clifford Street and continue for three weeks.

## What to expect:

- Construction will involve relocating services, below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Temporary footpath closures on the eastern footpath will occur. Works are being undertaken at night to maintain access to businesses at all times during opening hours.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Night work will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, Sunday to Thursday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
