

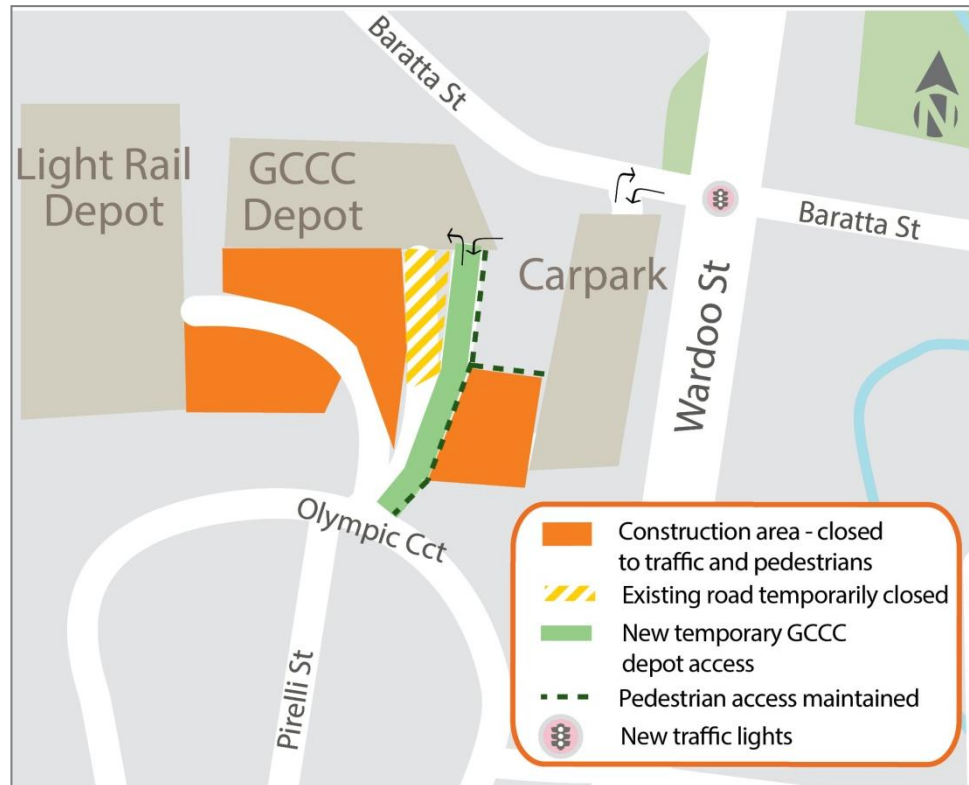
Temporary Gold Coast City Council access

Access to and from the Gold Coast City Council Depot, Southport will change in late May. Access will be via a temporary road adjacent to the existing access.

The existing gate house will be removed and a security guard will be in place at the temporary entry gate. The security guard will control visitor access to the council depot.

Traffic changes:

- Traffic will be diverted to a temporary access road east of the existing entry while construction of a new intersection and track form into the light rail depot occurs.
- Temporary lane closures within the Depot with left in and left out at the main gate.
- Reduced speed limit to 20 km/h on the access road and within the GCCC Depot.
- Entry to the car park will remain via Baratta Street only.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area (see map). Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and pedestrians will be re-directed along the new light rail corridor alignment



What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Security and traffic control in place.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements.
- Relocation of services, construction of track form, footpaths, kerbs and roadway.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
