



Temporary road closure and night works

To upgrade underground services a temporary road closure will occur on Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Ocean Avenue and Staghorn Avenue on Wednesday 29 and Thursday 30 May, 2013. Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses at Ocean Avenue during these closures.

Traffic impacts:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to through traffic at Ocean Avenue from 6:30am Wednesday 29 May to 6:30pm Thursday 30 May 2013.
- Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained at Ocean Avenue under traffic management.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be re-opened to all southbound traffic following these works.
- Through traffic will be detoured to the Gold Coast Highway or the Esplanade at Ocean Avenue and detours will be in place to access Surfers Paradise Boulevard.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction.

What to expect:

- Day and night works will take place during these works.
- Construction will involve relocating services below ground.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements, to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
