



Night works

Works along Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Beach Road and Trickett Street will take place for an additional two nights on Monday 27 and Wednesday 29 May 2013, to finalise underground service upgrades.

These works are scheduled to take place at night to minimise the impact on pedestrians, traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.

Night works:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will remain open to southbound traffic during these works. No further temporary road closures will be required.
- This work will be carried out between 6:30pm and 6:30am, Monday 27 and Wednesday 28 May 2013.
- Construction will involve finalising the installation of underground services.
- Temporary footpath closures may occur around the active work area.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration may occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
