

## Staghorn Avenue temporary closure

From Monday 3 June 2013, the intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all east-west traffic for approximately five weeks.

This is to allow the installation of storm water drainage and to undertake track form preparation and rail laying.

### Traffic changes:

- The intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all east-west through traffic (see map). Access to Surfers Paradise from Staghorn Avenue will be maintained at certain times when possible.
- Through traffic southbound on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be maintained.
- Local access to Staghorn Avenue will be maintained via the Gold Coast Highway and the Esplanade. Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.

### What to expect:

- Construction crews will work between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.
- Some night works will be required. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- Detours will be signed.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation, crane movements and rail deliveries to facilitate construction activities.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.

**Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.**
