



Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 3 June 2013



Parklands

There will be changed traffic conditions around Alumni Drive. Track form and underground service works along Parklands Drive and within the underground station continue.

Depot

Track form work and night works constructing the noise wall at the Baratta Street side of the Depot yard will occur.

Southport

Queen Street

Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Construction of Queen Street Station nears completion. There will be night works and partial lane closures in both directions for landscaping between Wardoo and Nerang Streets. Local access will be maintained.

Nerang Street

Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation including concrete pours and kerb work continues. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Construction of Southport Station continues.

Scarborough Street

Corner Scarborough and Nerang St (outside the Lucky 7 store)

Work to rebuild an Energex pit in the footpath area continues.

Between Nerang Street and Australia Fair

Drainage work, track form construction and electrical conduit installation continues. Kerb work will commence.

Between Lawson Street and White Street

Pavement and drainage works continue.

Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying preparation and construction of Southport South Station continues in the centre median. Some night time lane closures may be required.

Between Short Street and Australia Fair

Track form and drainage works will continue.

Between Short Street and Park Lane

Water main works continue opposite the RSL.

Lawson Street

Work to install the storm water system, traffic signal conduits and footpath kerb continues. Lawson Street will reopen to traffic in late June.

Short Street

Work on the storm water system continues. Short Street will reopen to through traffic at the Scarborough Street intersection in mid-June.

Queen Street

Near the Croquet Club

Track laying preparation and drainage work continues.

Barney Street

Track preparation works continue.

Nerang River

Construction continues on the bridge piers including piling and headstocks.

Nerang River Barge Movements

The barge Leonora continues to work from south to north completing piling. The navigation channel under the existing traffic bridge has now moved to the south of its charted position. Approaches to the bridge are marked and vessels should use extreme caution when transiting this area.

Mariners should obey speed limits, buoys and signs and are advised of the reduced overhead clearance at the temporary navigation span of four metres at the highest astronomical tide. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

Paradise Waters

Admiralty Drive

Concrete pours of the track form will continue at the northern side of Admiralty Drive. Following these works traffic will switch to allow rail to be laid across the southern part of the intersection.

Traffic access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained, however points of access may change.

Macintosh Island South bridge

Preparation and piling works for the bridge structure continue while underground service works continues near Jarri Parilla Cove.

Surfers Paradise

Ferny Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling, underground services and track form preparation continue with some night works required on both Surfers Paradise Boulevard and the Gold Coast Highway.

Gold Coast Highway Traffic Diversions

From Thursday 6 June 2013, the Gold Coast Highway will be closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection with Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue with traffic diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Detours will be signed and southbound traffic will be given priority right turn movements into Ocean Avenue to return to the Gold Coast Highway.

Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Underground service and track form preparation continues. Night works will be required on Sunday 2 June and Monday 3 June to install a water main to the south of Ocean Avenue.

The [intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard](#) will be closed to all east-west traffic from Monday 3 June for approximately five weeks to complete drainage and track form works. Through traffic southbound will be maintained on Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will reopen Friday 7 June

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be reopened to southbound traffic from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue and from Clifford Street to Thornton Street on Friday 7 June. Southbound traffic will travel on the tracks from Hamilton Avenue to Thornton Street.

Underground service upgrades, track works and finishing works will continue in the area, prior to the opening including night works from 6:30pm to 6:30am.

Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Works at the intersection of Cavill Avenue will continue next week. Night works will take place from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sunday to Thursday. Access through the intersection will be maintained. Works to install underground services along the eastern and western footpath will also occur.

Beach Road to Trickett Street

There is no access from Surfers Paradise Boulevard into Hanlan Street and Beach Road. Hanlan Street is also a left turn only onto the boulevard.

Trickett Street to Clifford Street

Works to install underground services continue. Night works will take place between Trickett Street and Laycock Street from Sunday to Thursday between 6:30pm to 6:30am.

Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between [Clifford and Thornton Street](#) remain closed until Friday 7 June. All intersections for east to west traffic movement are open. Underground service upgrades, track works and finishing works will continue in the area, including night works from 6:30pm to 6:30am. Preparatory works for the demolition of vacant buildings on the corner of Surfers Paradise Boulevard and Hamilton Avenue will begin.

Enderley Avenue Intersection

Works to install rail across the Enderley Avenue intersection continue. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals. Night works to install rail at the intersection will take place from 6:30pm to 6:30am from Sunday 3 June for up to four nights.

Thornton Street Intersection

Works to install rail across the Thornton Street intersection continue. To maintain access at all times traffic will be reduced to a single lane and managed by temporary traffic signals. Night works to install rail at the intersection will take place from 6:30pm to 6:30am from Sunday 3 June for up to four nights. Piling continues in this area.

Broadbeach

Gold Coast Highway

Australia Avenue partial intersection closure

Construction work is progressing at the intersection. For the duration of these works [Australia Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway is left-in/left-out only](#). Northbound access to Australia Avenue is available on the Gold Coast Highway via a U-turn at St Kilda Avenue. Pedestrian access to cross the highway is available via the convention centre crossing. Periodic temporary single lane closures northbound and southbound on the Gold Coast Highway will also occur.

Queensland Avenue

Underground service works continue on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway. Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

Main Place

Night works will take place this week to cross the Gold Coast Highway from T E Peter's Drive to the southern end of Main Place. These works will occur from Monday to Thursday from 6:30pm to 6:30am. Periodic lane closures of the Gold Coast Highway will occur.

Hooker Boulevard intersection

Work continues at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard and the Gold Coast Highway. One southbound right turn lane from the Gold Coast Highway onto Hooker Boulevard will be maintained. For traffic travelling east on Hooker Boulevard a left-turn lane, through-right and right-turn lane will be maintained at the intersection. Existing bus services will not be impacted during construction.

Timing of these works is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
