



## Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 10 June 2013



### Parklands

---

Excavation for track form will continue around Alumni Place.

### Depot

---

Work on the control room has commenced. Track laying continues and work on the Council entrance and gatehouse will begin this week.

### Southport

---

#### Queen Street

##### Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Construction of Queen Street Station is nearly complete. There may be night works and partial lane closures in both directions. Local access will be maintained.

#### Nerang Street

##### Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation including concrete pours and kerb work continues. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

##### Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Construction of Southport Station continues.

#### Scarborough Street

##### Between Nerang Street and Australia Fair

Drainage work, track form construction and electrical conduit installation continues. Kerb work will commence.

##### Between Lawson Street and White Street

Pavement and drainage works continue.

##### Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying preparation and construction of Southport South Station continues in the centre median. Some night time lane closures may be required.

##### Between Short Street and Australia Fair

Track form and drainage works will continue.

##### Between Short Street and Park Lane

Water main works continue opposite the RSL.

#### Lawson Street

Work to install the storm water system, traffic signal conduits and footpath kerb continues. Lawson Street at the Scarborough Street intersection will reopen to traffic in late June.

#### Short Street

Work on the storm water system and installing electrical conduits for the traffic lights continues. Short Street will reopen to traffic at the Scarborough Street intersection in late June.

#### Queen Street

##### Near the Croquet Club

Track laying preparation and drainage work continues.

#### Barney Street

A crane will be placed at the end of Barney Street late next week to lift bridge beams. The work will be completed at night and is expected to take two nights to complete. There will be some lane closures at this time.

### Nerang River

---

Construction continues on the bridge piers including piling and headstocks.

#### Nerang River Barge Movements

The barge Leonora continues to work from south to north completing piling. The navigation channel under the existing traffic bridge has now moved to the south of its charted position. Approaches to the bridge are marked and vessels should use extreme caution when transiting this area.

Mariners should obey speed limits, buoys and signs and are advised of the reduced overhead clearance at the temporary navigation span of four metres at the highest astronomical tide. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

### Paradise Waters

---

#### Admiralty Drive

Track form works at the northern side of Admiralty Drive intersection and towards Waterways Drive will continue. Traffic and pedestrian access into and out of Paradise

### Macintosh Island South Bridge

Bridge construction continues. [Piling works](#) are scheduled to commence from Thursday 13 June while underground service works continues near Jarri Parilla Cove.

## Surfers Paradise

### Surfers Paradise Boulevard Closures

From Tuesday 18 June 2013 the final section of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Cavill Avenue and Clifford Street will be closed for up to three months to facilitate construction of the Gold Coast light rail.

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all through traffic from Beach Road to Clifford Street. Temporary block and intersection closures will occur from Cavill Avenue to Alison Street. Waste collection and delivery loading bays will be maintained via local or side street access.

Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions.

Support Surfers Paradise traders throughout the construction period by eating, shopping and playing locally.

### Ferny Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling, underground services and track form preparation continue with some night works required on both Surfers Paradise Boulevard and the Gold Coast Highway.

### Gold Coast Highway Traffic Diversions

The Gold Coast Highway is closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection with Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue with traffic diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Detours will be signed and southbound traffic will be given priority right turn movements into Ocean Avenue to return to the Gold Coast Highway.

### Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Underground service and track form preparation continues and some night works may be required.

The [intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard](#) will remain closed until mid July to all east-west traffic to complete drainage and track form works. Southbound traffic will be maintained on Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

### Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Following the completion of major construction, Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now open to southbound traffic. Footpath, landscaping and station works will continue. Night works to finalise underground service installations will take place from 1:00am to 7:00am, Monday to Wednesday.

### Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Night works will occur from Monday 10 June to Thursday 13 June. A temporary road closure will be in place from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Tuesday to Thursday.

### Beach Road to Trickett Street

Hanlan Street is a left turn only onto Surfers Paradise Boulevard and there is no access from the boulevard into Hanlan Street. There is also no access from Beach Road into Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

### Trickett Street to Clifford Street

Works to install underground services along the eastern and western footpath will occur, during these works temporary footpath closures may occur.

### Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between [Clifford and Thornton Street](#) have reopened. Works to complete traffic signals, underground service installations at Enderley and Hamilton Avenues and finishing works will continue from 6:30am to 6:30pm from Monday to Saturday.

## Broadbeach

### Gold Coast Highway

#### Australia Avenue

The Australia Avenue intersection remains left-in/left-out this week. Northbound access to Australia Avenue is available on the Gold Coast Highway via a U-turn at St Kilda Avenue. Pedestrian access to cross the highway is available via the convention centre crossing. Periodic temporary single lane closures will occur. The intersection is expected to reopen on 15 June.

#### Queensland Avenue

Underground service works continue on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway. Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

### Convention Centre

The northern bus stop at the convention centre is now closed.

### Main Place

Night works from 6:30pm to 6:30am for underground service upgrades will begin on Monday 10 June. Traffic management will be in place for the duration of these works.

### Margaret Avenue

Underground service works will begin on the corner of Margaret Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway. The works will be completed at night from 6:30pm to 6:30am and will take four days to complete.

### Hooker Boulevard intersection

Work continues at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard and the Gold Coast Highway. One southbound right turn lane from the Gold Coast Highway onto Hooker Boulevard will be maintained. For traffic travelling east on Hooker Boulevard a left-turn lane, through-right and right-turn lane will be maintained at the intersection. Existing bus services will not be impacted during construction.

**Timing of these works is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.**

## SURFERS PARADISE BOULEVARD CLOSURES
