



## Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 17 June 2013



### Parklands

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Track form work around Alumni Place and work building the station at Engineering Drive will continue.

### Depot

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Work on the interior fit out of the depot building continues. Track laying and work on the Council entrance and gatehouse also continues.

### Southport

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#### Queen Street

##### Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Landscaping continues with sections of the street now complete. Construction of Queen Street Station also continues.

#### Nerang Street

##### Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation including concrete pours and kerb work continues. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

##### Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Construction of Southport Station continues.

#### Scarborough Street

##### Between Nerang Street and Australia Fair

Drainage work, track form construction and electrical conduit installation continues. Kerb work will commence.

##### Between Lawson Street and White Street

Pavement and drainage works continue.

##### Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying preparation and construction of Southport South Station continues in the centre median. Some night time lane closures may be required.

##### Between Short Street and Australia Fair

Track form and drainage work will continue. Work to align the rail outside Australia Fair will start.

##### Between Short Street and Park Lane

Water main works continue opposite the RSL.

#### Lawson Street

Work to install the storm water system, traffic signal conduits and footpath kerb continues. Lawson Street at the Scarborough Street intersection will reopen to traffic in late June.

#### Short Street

Work on the storm water system and installing electrical conduits for the traffic lights continues. Short Street will reopen to traffic at the Scarborough Street intersection in late June.

#### Queen Street

##### Near the Croquet Club

Rail will be delivered to the Broadwater Parklands Station site. There will be night time works for drainage.

#### Barney Street

A crane will be placed at the end of Barney Street late next week to lift bridge beams. The work will be completed at night and is expected to take two nights to complete. There will be traffic control and all access will still be available.

### Nerang River

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Construction continues on bridge decks and bridge piers including piling and headstocks.

#### Nerang River Barge Movements

The barges continue to work from south to north completing piling. The navigation channel under the existing traffic bridge has now moved to the south of its charted position. Approaches to the bridge are marked and vessels should use extreme caution when transiting this area.

Mariners should obey speed limits, buoys and signs and are advised of the reduced overhead clearance at the temporary navigation span of four metres at the highest astronomical tide. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

### Paradise Waters

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#### Admiralty Drive

Track form works continue from the Admiralty Drive intersection towards Waterways Drive. Traffic and pedestrian access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained, however

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points of access may change. Pedestrians are advised to follow directions from traffic controllers.

### Macintosh Island South Bridge

Piling works will continue with short term closures to the navigational channel and pedestrian footpaths at certain times.

## Surfers Paradise

### Ferny Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling, underground services and track form preparation continue with some night works required on both Surfers Paradise Boulevard and the Gold Coast Highway.

### Gold Coast Highway Traffic Diversions

The Gold Coast Highway is closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection with Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue with traffic diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Detours will be signed and southbound traffic will be given priority right turn movements into Ocean Avenue to return to the Gold Coast Highway.

### Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Underground service and track form preparation continues. The intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will remain closed until mid July to all east-west traffic to complete drainage and track form works. Night works will be required from Sunday 19 June. Southbound traffic will be maintained on Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

### Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now open to southbound traffic. Footpath, landscaping and station works will continue.

### Surfers Paradise Boulevard Closures

From Tuesday 18 June 2013 the final section of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Beach Road and Clifford Street will be closed for up to three months to facilitate construction of the Gold Coast light rail. Waste collection and delivery loading bays will be maintained via local or side street access.

Temporary block and intersection closures will occur from Cavill Avenue to Alison Street. Waste collection and delivery loading bays will be maintained via local or side street access.

Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions.

Support Surfers Paradise traders throughout the construction period by eating, shopping and playing locally.

### Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Works to install underground services within the construction area continue.

### Beach Road to Trickett Street

Beach and Hanlan Streets are left turn only onto Surfers Paradise Boulevard and there is no access from the boulevard into Hanlan Street or Beach Street.

### Alison Street Intersection Closure

From 6:00pm Wednesday 19 June to 6:00pm Saturday 22 June, the intersection of Alison Street and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to complete track laying.

Local access to Appel Street and Alison Street via Clifford Street will be maintained under traffic control for the duration of the closure. Appel Street will become two-way during this time.

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### Trickett Street to Clifford Street

Works to install underground services within the construction area and along the eastern and western footpath will occur. Works to install underground services across the western side of Clifford Street will begin. Traffic management will be in place to assist motorists at all times.

### Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between Clifford and Thornton Street have reopened. Works to complete traffic signals, underground service installations at Enderley and Hamilton Avenues and finishing works will continue from 6:30am to 6:30pm from Monday to Saturday.

## Broadbeach

### Gold Coast Highway

#### Australia Avenue partial intersection closure

The centre median of the intersection will be reopened to traffic on 15 June 2013, weather permitting. Right turn traffic movements into and out of Australia Avenue will be reinstated.

#### Queensland Avenue

Underground service works continue at night on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway. Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

#### Main Place

Night works will continue from Sunday 16 June to Thursday 20 June from the Gold Coast Highway to Main Place. The underground service works will occur from 6:30pm to 6:30am and periodic lane closures will occur.

#### Hooker Boulevard intersection

Hooker Boulevard intersection works continue. For vehicles travelling south an additional right turn lane into Hooker Boulevard will reopen later in the week.

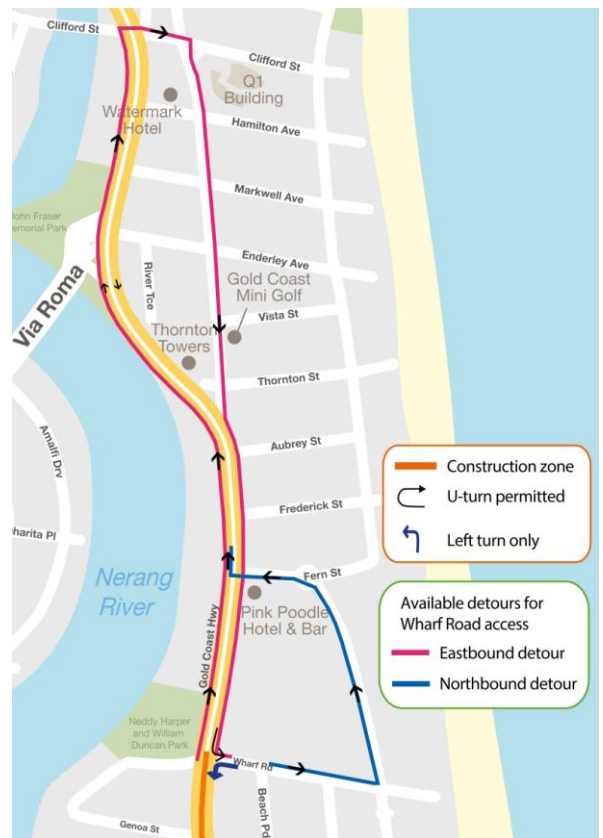
#### Margaret Avenue intersection

From Sunday 16 June night works will commence on underground services at the intersection of Margaret Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway. Periodic lane closures will occur during these works from 6:30pm to 6:30am.

## Gold Coast Highway and Wharf Road Partial Intersection Closure

From Sunday night 16 June 2013, the intersection of Wharf Road and the Gold Coast Highway will be partially closed and become left in / left out only. For motorists travelling north a detour is available via Wharf Road and Fern Street eastbound.

For motorists wanting to cross the intersection eastbound a detour is available via Gold Coast Highway and Clifford Street westbound. Temporary single lane closures northbound and southbound on the Gold Coast Highway will also occur. It is anticipated the works will take four weeks to complete.
