

Underground service works Gold Coast Highway Broadbeach

From 7:00pm Wednesday 26 June to 3:00pm Thursday 27 June 2013, water main works will be completed in the southbound lane of the Gold Coast Highway before the Hooker Boulevard intersection.

Traffic changes:

- The two Gold Coast Highway southbound lanes will be diverted around the construction site.
- One right turn lane into Hooker Boulevard southbound from the Gold Coast Highway.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained.

From Monday 1 July 2013, night works to upgrade and install underground services will begin along the Gold Coast Highway from Margaret Avenue towards the Beach Hotel. These works will take four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Traffic changes:

- Periodic slow lane closures of the Gold Coast Highway.
- The foot path from the Beach Hotel to Margaret Avenue will be closed. A temporary foot path will be provided around the works area.
- Driveway crossings will be completed in halves. Access to properties will be maintained.

What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
