



Local Access during the Gold Coast Airport Marathon

On Sunday 7 July 2013, the Esplanade will be closed from Ferny Avenue to Clifford Street as part of the 35th Annual Gold Coast Airport Marathon.

During this time, GoldLinQ will maintain local access for residents and businesses in Hanlan Street, Trickett Street, Laycock Street, Alison Street and Appel Street from Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

What to expect:

- The Esplanade will be closed to all through traffic from Ferny Avenue to Clifford Street between 3:30am and 12:00pm on Sunday 7 July 2013.
- Local access via Surfers Paradise Boulevard will only be available from 3:30am to 12:00pm on Sunday 7 July.

Traffic changes:

- Local access both in and out of Hanlan Street, Trickett Street, Laycock Street and Alison Street will be maintained under traffic control for the duration of the closure.
- A single lane of traffic will be reopened along Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Beach Road to Laycock Street (see map).
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the area. Temporary footpath closures may occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- For safety, please drive to the conditions and follow the direction of traffic controllers at all times.



Night works:

- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
