

## T E Peters Drive Gold Coast Highway partial intersection closure

From 7:00pm Wednesday night 24 July 2013, the intersection of T E Peters Drive and the Gold Coast Highway will be partially closed to facilitate light rail construction works. These works will take eight days to complete and the closure will re-open to traffic at 7:00pm on 1 August 2013.

### Traffic changes:

- The intersection of T E Peters Drive and the Gold Coast Highway will be partially closed. Left-in/left-out only.
- For westbound traffic access is available via Elizabeth Avenue or Hooker Boulevard.
- For eastbound traffic access is available via Elizabeth Avenue or Australia Avenue.
- For pedestrians a new signalised pedestrian crossing will be opened at the intersection of Queensland Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway.
- Periodic Gold Coast Highway lane closures for rail delivery at off-peak times.



### What to expect:

- Construction works will be completed during day and night works 24/7 during the eight day closure.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

## 745 and 750 changes to bus routes:

**There are changes to the 745 and 750 bus services during the eight day partial closure (see map).**

- Bus Route 745 southbound detoured via Victoria Avenue and Hooker Boulevard.
- Bus Route 750 northbound detoured via Surf Parade.
- Bus Route 750 southbound detoured via the Gold Coast Highway and Hooker Boulevard.
- Pedestrians using both 750 services and the 745 southbound service, access to Jupiter's Casino is available via the monorail. The monorail stations are located within the Oasis Shopping Centre on Victoria Avenue and at Jupiter's Casino.



## Night works:

**Night works will be required to complete these works within the eight day partial closure.**

- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Construction noise impacts will be minimised during night works.
