



Gold Coast Light Rail

Week Commencing Monday 15 July 2013



Parklands

Track work around Alumni Place and station construction at Engineering Drive continues.

Depot

Work on the interior fit out of the Depot building continues. Track laying and work on the Council entrance and gatehouse also continues.

Smith Street Bridge

There will be lane closures and detours in place at night during the week to facilitate crane lifts onto the bridge.

Southport

Queen Street

Between Wardoo and Nerang Streets

Final works including traffic signal testing will occur.

Nerang Street

Between Queen and Davenport Streets

Track preparation including concrete pours and kerb work continues. There will be occasional night time lane closures for this work.

Between Davenport and Scarborough Streets

Construction of Southport Station continues.

Scarborough Street

There will be changed traffic arrangements in Scarborough Street next week outside Australia

Fair, the RSL and Lawson Street as traffic moves to its final position.

Between Nerang Street and Australia Fair

Drainage work and kerb preparation continues. There will be a partial closure of the laneway next to the HSBC Bank to allow a storm water pit to be constructed.

Between Australia Fair and Short Streets

Southbound traffic will move to eastern side of the road, to allow track form work to start in the centre of the road.

Between Lawson Street and White Street

Northbound traffic will move to the western side of the road, to allow track form work to start in the centre of the road. The bus stop located outside the RSL will move back to its permanent position.

Between White and Queen Streets

Track laying preparation and construction of Southport South Station continues in the centre median. Some night time lane closures may be required.

Between Lawson Street and Park Lane

Pavement and kerb work continues.

Lawson Street

Lawson Street will reopen to left in and left out only. There will be no through access to Short Street for several weeks as track laying is still to occur in the centre median.

Short Street

Short Street will partially reopen to traffic mid July, with a left turn in from Scarborough Street. There will be no through access to Lawson Street for several weeks as track laying is still to occur in the centre median (see map below).

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Queen Street

Station construction preparation and drainage work continues.

Barney Street

Track laying preparation continues.

Southport Broadwater Parklands

A temporary construction site is now established in the Broadwater Parklands to allow construction to start on the pedestrian and cycle bridge. Pedestrian and cycle access under and over the bridge will be maintained during construction.

Nerang River

Construction continues on bridge decks and bridge piers including piling and headstocks.

Nerang River Barge Movements

The large barge Leonora will continue with piling works on the northern side of the navigation channel. Approaches to the bridge are marked and vessels should use extreme caution when transiting this area.

Mariners should obey speed limits, buoys and signs and are advised of the reduced overhead clearance at the temporary navigation span of four metres at the highest astronomical tide. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

Paradise Waters

Admiralty Drive

Track work continues. Traffic access into and out of Paradise Waters will be maintained, however points of access may change.

Macintosh Island South Bridge

Steel installation and concreting for headstock construction continues. Work to remove temporary rock barriers within the navigation channel will occur. Access for vessels under the bridge will be maintained however short delays may occur.

Surfers Paradise

Gold Coast Highway Traffic Diversions and Night Works

The Gold Coast Highway is closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection of [Ferry Avenue to Ocean Avenue](#) with traffic diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Ferry Avenue to Main Beach Parade

Piling, underground services and track form preparation continue on Surfers Paradise Boulevard. Underground services work will occur at the Gold Coast Highway. Night and weekend works including Sundays will be required throughout this area.

Ocean Avenue to View Avenue

Underground service and track form preparation continues. The [intersection of Staghorn Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard](#) will remain closed to all east-west traffic. Some night works will be required. Southbound traffic will be maintained on Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Underground service works and preparation for track form construction will continue near Cypress Avenue and construction of electrical pit near View Street will occur including night works.

Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is now open to southbound traffic. Footpath, landscaping and station works will continue.

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Surfers Paradise Boulevard Closures

Surfers Paradise Boulevard between [Beach Road and Clifford Street](#) is now closed for up to three months. Waste collection and delivery loading bays will be maintained via local or side street access. Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions.

Cavill Avenue to Beach Road

Night works to install underground services will continue this week from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Monday to Friday. Works will take place at the intersection of Cavill Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard and on the eastern footpath from Cavill Avenue to Beach Road.

Night works will also continue west down Cavill Avenue outside of business hours from midnight to 10am, Sunday to Thursday.

Beach Road to Trickett Street

Hanlan Street is now closed to all east and westbound traffic. For access to Hanlan Street, including Centro Shopping Centre, please use the Esplanade. Access to The Islander will be maintained.

Trickett Street to Clifford Street

Night works to prepare for track installation will take place from 6:30pm to 6:30am Monday to Friday.

Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Southbound traffic movements between Clifford and Thornton Street have reopened. Works to finalise underground service installations, install traffic signals, complete footpath, landscaping and station works will continue. Thornton Street will be reopened to all east-west traffic movements on Tuesday 12 July 2013.

From Monday 15 July 2013, works will commence to demolish the vacant property at 2999-3001 Surfers Paradise Boulevard, Surfers Paradise. Temporary footpath and lane closures may occur. Traffic management will be in place to assist.

Broadbeach

Gold Coast Highway Second Avenue

Rail delivery, track laying and concrete pours continue from Second Avenue towards Australia Avenue. Periodic lane closures will occur.

Queensland Avenue

Preparatory works for installing the signals at the intersection will begin. Temporary lane closures will occur. Access to Queensland Avenue and Main Place will be maintained.

Main Place

Underground services and drainage works continue at Main Place. Periodic left hand slip lane closures will occur. Access into Main Place will be maintained.

Elizabeth Avenue

Underground services and track form preparation works will occur.

Margaret Avenue

Night works to upgrade and install underground services continue along the Gold Coast Highway from Margaret Avenue towards the Beach Hotel. Periodic slow lane closures of the Gold Coast Highway will occur.
