

## Surfers Paradise Boulevard night works

To facilitate underground services construction, night works will take place along the eastern footpath of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Cavill Avenue and Hanlan Street from Monday 15 July 2013, from 6:30pm to 6:30am.

These works are scheduled to take place at night for up to one week to minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.

## Night works:

- Southbound traffic on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will maintained during the works.
- Temporary footpath closures at the intersection may occur and along the
  eastern footpath from Cavill Avenue to Hanlan Street. Traffic management will
  be in place to assist pedestrians and alternative routes and redirections will be
  signed.
- Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
- This work will be carried out between 6:30pm and 6:30am from Monday 15
   July 2013 for up to one week.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration may occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
