

Admiralty Drive Slip Lane Closure

From 6:30am Tuesday 20 August 2013, the left turn slip lane from Admiralty Drive onto the Gold Coast Highway will be permanently closed in line with the final traffic alignment for the corridor.

Motorists exiting Paradise Waters to travel northbound on the Gold Coast Highway will need to do so at the signalised intersection (see map).

Traffic changes:

- The slip lane providing a left turn from Admiralty Drive onto the Gold Coast Highway northbound will be permanently closed.
- Vehicles travelling north will exit Admiralty Drive via a dedicated left turn only lane. Eastbound and southbound traffic will be maintained via a single lane (see map).
- Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.

What to expect:

- Night works will be required on Monday 19 August from 6:30pm to remove the slip lane. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions during these road works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residence.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Construction will include line-marking and traffic signal works.
- Traffic controllers and detour signs will be in place.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed. Pedestrians need to be aware that following traffic control directions is vital for their safety.

- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.




Admiralty Drive Final Alignment During Light Rail Operations
