

Traffic changes on Scarborough Street and Nerang Street Mall

From Thursday 10 October 2013, Scarborough Street in Southport will become one-way southbound between Nerang Street and Queen Street.

Footpath paving, landscape and finishing works will be undertaken progressively in sections over ten weeks, with pedestrian access and one-way southbound traffic access maintained at all times.

Access to driveways and businesses between Nerang Street and Queen Street will be maintained.

Traffic changes:

- Scarborough Street will be one-way southbound between Queen and Nerang Streets (see map adjacent).
- Northbound detour will be via Queen, Garden and Davenport Streets.
- Access to Scarborough Street from Lawson Street will be right turn only.
- Access to Scarborough Street from Young Street, White Street and Owens Lane will be closed. Local driveway access will be maintained.
- Access to Scarborough Street from Short Street and Park Lane will be left turn only.

Nerang Street Mall changes

- Nerang Street Mall will become one-way westbound to facilitate bus movements through the shared zone.
- Pedestrians are advised to take care as buses will be moving through the shared zone.
- The taxi rank located on Nerang Street Mall will now travel westbound.

Bus route changes:

What to expect:

- Construction crews will work day and night Monday to Saturday to complete the finishing works.
- Night works will be required from 6:30pm to 6:30pm.
- Pedestrian access will be signed around the work area and will be maintained at all times.
- Safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area will be in place.
- Construction will include excavation, concreting and installation of paving and landscaping.
- Noise, dust and vibration associated with construction may occur at times and every effort will be made to minimise these.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residents.

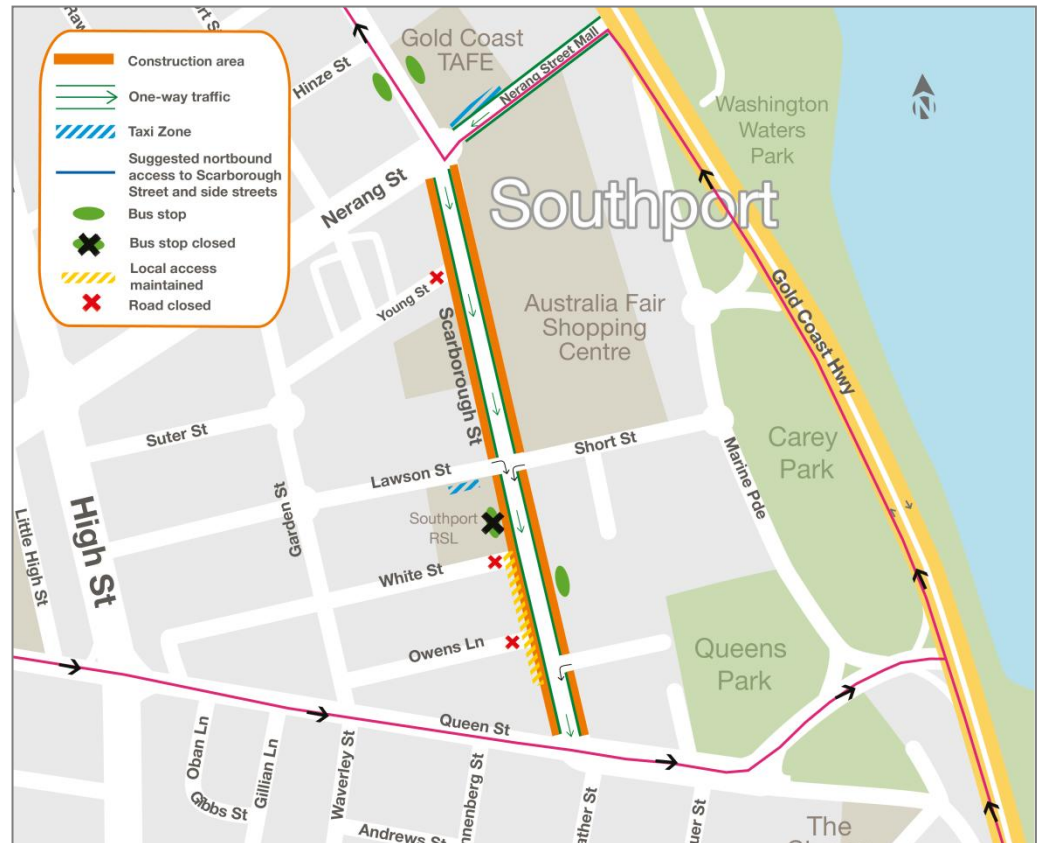


Bus changes on Scarborough Street

Bus route changes:

- Southbound bus stops on Scarborough Street will be maintained.
- Northbound bus routes 5, 18, 18A, 700, 702, 703, 706, 709, 715 & 737 will be diverted via the Gold Coast Highway and the Nerang Street Mall.
- The northbound bus stop on the western side of Scarborough Street near Southport RSL will be temporarily closed.
- The nearest alternative bus stop is located 500 metres along Scarborough Street opposite Gold Coast TAFE (see map).
