



Night Works on View Avenue

From Tuesday 8 October 2013, night works to install underground services at the intersection of View Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard will begin and continue for up to four nights. This work will be undertaken in stages to maintain local and vehicle access at all times.

What to expect:

- Installation of safety fencing and hoarding to contain the work area.
- Construction will involve relocating services, below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Traffic management will be in place to pedestrians and motorists. Please drive to the conditions at all times as points of access will change.
- Pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained around the work site at all times.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Tuesday to Friday, 6:30pm to 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
